## Stunning Salt Painting

Did you know you can paint with salt? Create beautiful works of art with just salt, glue and a little bit of paint or food colouring.

## What You'll Need

- \* Thick white card
- \* Salt (you'll need a good amount, but you'll be able to re-use it continually)
- \* White glue with a small nozzle
- \* Small paintbrush
- \* Water
- Liquid watercolour paint (you can use food colouring instead if you don't have liquid watercolour paint)

## Instructions

- \* Print off one of the templates on the following pages onto the card, or you can draw an image to trace over if you prefer.
- \* Using the bottle of glue, carefully trace over the entire image on the card.
- \* Now carefully sprinkle the image with salt. You will need to pour a LOT of salt on the page to ensure you coat every part of it.
- \* Gently pour off the excess salt and allow the glue to dry. You can reuse the excess salt several times.
- \* Once dry, the salt image is ready to paint. Dilute the liquid paint in a small amount of water. Alternatively, add some drops of food colouring to water to paint with.
- \* Using a small amount of paint at a time, gently tap the salt image with the paintbrush. The salt will soak up the watercolour from the brush and spread like magic!
- \* Once you've painted the whole salt image, allow the artwork to dry and then display.
