## Fabulous fizzy Chalk

What's more exciting than drawing with chalk? How about painting with fizzy chalk! Mix up a batch of fizzy chalk paint using everyday household ingredients and watch your kids create masterpieces on cement or pavers. And the best part - it washes off with water. Here's how you make it.

### Ingredients

- ◇ 1/4 cup cornflour
- ◇ 250g baking soda
- ◇ 1/2 cup cold water
- ◇ A few squirts of dishwashing liquid
- ◇ A few drops of food colouring
- ◇ White vinegar

### How to Make It

- ◇ Combine the cornflour, baking soda, water and dishwashing liquid in a large bowl. Add the food colouring. You may like to divide your mixture first to make multiple colours. An old muffin tin makes a great paint palette for different colours.
- ◇ Your mixture is now ready to paint with.
- ◇ For extra fizzing fun, pour some white vinegar in a spray bottle. Spray the artwork with the vinegar and watch the paint fizz!
- ◇ When your child is finished painting simply wash everything away with water.
