

# DAILY BOREDOM BUSTER

## Pitching Pennies

A simple game to help with hand-eye coordination.

All you need are some coins and several buckets or large containers to toss the coins into.

### How to Play

- ◆ Assign a value to each bucket or container - the values are the amount of points won for each successful toss.
- ◆ Line the buckets up in a row from lowest to highest value (see picture).
- ◆ Draw a starting line a little way in front of the lowest ranked bucket for your players to stand behind.
- ◆ Each player receives 5 coins and takes it in turns to toss their coins into the buckets.
- ◆ At the end of each player's turn, add up the scores for the successful tosses.
- ◆ The player with the highest score wins!

**TIP:** You can also use marbles or ping pong balls instead of coins.
